

## **PARKING INFORMATION**

Provided by the City of Houston Parking Management Dept.

Please note that the following are VIOLATIONS and if caught, you may find a parking ticket on your windshield or that the vehicle has been towed.

### **It is illegal to park:**

- \* Blocking the sidewalk (even parked in your driveway). "Blocking" is a judgment call -- but if someone walking or using a wheelchair on the sidewalk has to go into the street to get around your vehicle, it's blocking.
- \* On the sidewalk.
- \* On the wrong side of the street -- or with right wheel more than 18" from the right curb (considered "parked wrong way")
- \* On the street for longer than 24 hours without vehicle moving (operable or inoperable).
- \* On a street closer than 15' of a fire hydrant.
- \* On a street closer than 20' of a crosswalk.
- \* On a street closer than 30' of a stop sign.
- \* On an esplanade, median strip or traffic island.
- \* On a bridge (including bridges over bayous/ditches).
- \* On a street for purpose of advertising (or to sell a vehicle)
- \* Within 50' of a railroad crossing.
- \* Double park.
